EDUCATION GRANT 2014

The Anglican Community which meets at the Chapel of the University of the West Indies, Mona Campus wishes to award education grants to three students (male or female) who have successfully completed the 1_{st} or 2_{nd} year of any undergraduate programme offered by the University of the West Indies. Preference will be given to those students who are pursuing an undergraduate degree for the first time. The grants are for one hundred thousand (\$100,000), eighty thousand (\$80,000) and fifty thousand (\$50,000). At least one grant will be given to a student who regularly attends the Anglican service at the Chapel.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

SECTION I

The applicant shall -

- i. be a Caribbean citizen and have resided within the Caribbean five years prior to the date of application,
- ii. be a person of good character,
- iii. have produced a certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner showing that he/she is medically fit to hold the scholarship,
- iv. be currently a full-time undergraduate student of the University of the West Indies, Mona Campus
- v. be a communicant member of Church in the Province of the West Indies (Anglican Church), and produce the relevant supporting documents (such as a confirmation certificate and/or recommendation) from an Anglican Priest,
- vi. be available to attend an interview if required by the selection committee.
- vii. in addition to other documents stated in (iii) and (v) above submit:
- 1. a letter of recommendation from a lecturer in the applicant's faculty and;
- 2. a character reference from the Rector or Church Warden of the applicant's local church;
- 3. a transcript regarding academic performance
- 4.an essay which should include outline of career goals and their relevance to the needs of your territory and/or the Caribbean region, a statement regarding involvement in the Anglican Community and related social extra-curricular activities elsewhere and a statement of how fees are currently being paid (not to exceed 600 words).

SECTION II

- i. The applicant for this grant shall NOT –
- a. be the holder of any other substantial monetary award or grants and;
- b. be the holder of any award which would interfere with the provisions of the terms and conditions of this grant.
