# 1ST PRE LAUNCH ACTIVITY




Music Director, Lorenzo Hall shared with parents what to expect from this year's project. He also answered questions about the steel pan.

Sis Maydene Campbell presented a gift to Apostle Cadence Roxborough.




A number of parents and guardians were present at the 1st pre launch activity.
